Special Memories - From time to time I troll the pages of Face Book social media. I am often delighted see on the screen an old navy photo that I took many decades ago. They were all for the printed page in those days but now they are seeing the light of day via

social media.

There is an old saying 'a picture is worth a thousand words' and the photo above certainly has many stories to tell. It is HMAS Brisbane sailing off into the sunset in the Persian Gulf in 1981.

I was three months into North West Indian Ocean deployment on board HMAS Brisbane as the ship's photographer. We were off the coast of Kenya when the Commanding Officer, Captain Jim Dickson, informed me that I was to be picked up in 10 minutes by the US Mail chopper so I would finally get a chance to take some shots of HMAS Brisbane up in these Indian Ocean waters.

The US Chopper arrived and the mail came on board. I went back up the cable into the well of the chopper. We did a few laps of the ship on sunset and I got some magnificent photos, including the easy shot that was going to make a nice cover for our cruise book.

Task completed, I was ready to be lowered back on board Brisbane but the pilot announced that we would be racing back to the mother ship, aircraft carrier USS America, for new duty. Once we landed on the flight deck I was sent below with two US photo mates to find a hot dog in the main galley. Content with a hotdog and coke, suddenly all hell brakes loose. BOOM! A thunderous explosion on the upper deck shuddered the ship.

"Attention all hands - fire on the upper deck" came the voice down the PA system.

The two US photo mates and I grabbed our camera bags and scrambled for the doorway, making our way to the upper flight deck. There before our eyes was the Sea King chopper I had just flown in on, burnt to a crisp! She had exploded during the refuelling procedure and was being pushed overboard whilst still burning. A small upper deck hazard, no one was hurt, flying continued as normal!

Two days later I was finally lowered back down onto the quarterdeck of HMAS Brisbane from another Sea King chopper. As my feet hit the deck the pipe was loud and clear "Leading Phot Lee, Captain's Cabin, with a bloody good excuse and you better have a great photo"



NAVY SEAPOWER CONFERENCE TIMELY UPDATE FOR AUSTRALIA ...

Welcome to the 13th Royal Australian Navy Indo-Pacific Sea Power Conference, held in conjunction with the Indo Pacific 2023 International Maritime Exposition.

The Indo-Pacific, our region, is rich in resources and for centuries it has been shaped and influenced by the waters that surround and connect us.

The world's oceans are global superhighways that facilitate the economic interdependence which now characterises the global economy.

Billions of people across the world rely upon the natural resources drawn from or transported on the oceans for their livelihood and for their future. Even more take for granted that unseen in the depths of the oceans lie the data cables which are the arteries and veins pumping and transferring data which animates the modern world.

This year's conference theme, "Fleet 2035: Sea Power and the Future of Maritime Warfare", is built from the reality that sea power is a ubiquitous element of Australian national security, and prosperity; yet we live in a maritime region that is being reshaped, and our strategic environment is becoming more challenging. The Maritime domain has once again become the frontline for strategic conversations between nations.

In parallel, the Royal Australian Navy is also proud to once again host the Navy Enlisted Leadership Conference 2023, widely known as The Sailors Forum. Focused on deck-plate leadership, this event shines a light on the role of our Sailors in building and fostering high functioning teams to animate our units and energise our Navy.

The outstanding speakers from around the world include Senior Government and Defence leadership, industry executives, and academics thought leaders participating are sure to make it a thought provoking rewarding event".

HYPERSONICS

BLAST MODELLING FEATURE INNOVATION AWARD WINNERS ...

ydney based company Hypersonix Launch Systems and Victoria's Thornton Tomasetti engineer, Rhys Centin, have been recognised with prestigious awards for outstanding Australian industry innovation at the Indo Pacific 2023 International Maritime Exposition in Sydney.

Professor Emily Hilder, Head of the Defence Advanced Strategic Capabilities Accelerator, presented the Indo Pacific 2023 Innovation Awards as part of the event at Sydney's International Convention Centre.

Hypersonix won both the National and the SME Innovation Awards, for its world-leading work developing a 3D-printed hypersonic vehicle and hydrogen-powered propulsion system, that have been selected by the United States Pentagon's Defense Innovation Unit for the Hypersonic High-Cadence Airborne Testing program.

The Young Innovator Award was presented to Melbourne-based Thornton Tomasetti engineer, Mr Rhys Centin, for his work on two projects: explosive ordnance blast modelling for the Royal Australian Navy; and shock-testing naval equipment weighing more than one tonne, using Australia's only JASSO shock-testing machine.

The panel of eight judges, led by former Director of the Defence Industry Innovation Centre Tony Quick, agreed that Hypersonix Launch Systems' entry was a worthy winner of both the National and SME awards, usually presented to separate companies. Winners of the SME Innovation Award and Young Innovator Award were presented with a cheque for \$50,000 each.

These monetary Awards, funded by Indo Pacific 2023 organiser AMDA Foundation Limited, are designed to be substantial enough to be lifechanging, especially for the winner of the Young Innovator Award.

"Once again our awards are highlighting the ingenuity of Australian individuals and organisations, which are proving themselves the equal of any in the world," said AMDA Foundation CEO Justin Giddings.

"These monetary awards are designed as rewards for their efforts and as a practical financial contribution to further innovation and the development of professional skills."

The Indo Pacific 2023 Innovation Awards recognise and reward Australian individuals and organisations at the forefront of defence innovation in products, services and business processes.

The Awards are open to Australian companies and the Australian divisions of international organisations.

Innovations are judged on their commercial success or market potential, understanding of user needs and originality.

Since the launch of the Innovation Awards program in 2012, Indo Pacific organiser AMDA Foundation has presented SME Innovation and Young Innovator Awards to a value of \$685,000 through its Avalon Australian International Airshow, Indo Pacific and Land Forces events.

This year the AMDA Foundation Board moved to increase the cash prize awards from \$15,000 to \$50,000 to encourage local innovation at a critical time in Australia's industrial and strategic development and to make a significant impact on a company's operations or the professional development of a young innovator.

Award Winners:

- **National Innovation Award**: Hypersonix Launch Systems (NSW) a designer and manufacturer of both the DART AE hypersonic air vehicle and Spartan hydrogen-powered hypersonic propulsion system; the DART AE and Spartan have been selected ahead of 60 contenders from around the globe by the Pentagon's Defense Innovation Unit for the Hypersonic High-Cadence Airborne Testing (HyCAT) program
- SME Innovation Award (\$50,000): Hypersonix Launch Systems (NSW)
- Young Innovator Award (\$50,000): Mr. Rhys Centin, Thornton Thomasetti (VIC), for his
 work on two projects: explosive ordnance blast modelling for the RAN; and shock-testing
 naval equipment weighing more than one tonne using Australia's only JASSO shocktesting machine

In addition, three Award contenders won a High Commendation:

- **SME Innovation Award HIGH COMMENDATION**: Advanced Navigation (NSW) for the development of the Hydrus fully autonomous submersible drone, designed for one-person launch and recovery, for undersea surveying, detection, localisation, classification and inspection
- **SME Innovation Award HIGH COMMENDATION**: AMOG (Vic) for developing an innovative, flexible monitoring solution that provides independent diagnostics, validation and oversight on the performance of critical wharf infrastructure
- Young Innovator Award HIGH COMMENDATION: Mr. Joshua Cribb of Electro Nautic (WA) for his work as co-founder on designing and testing the electromechanical and flight controls of the Electro Nautic 'WaveFlyer' recreational and defence vessel

The Memorial Scholarship Award is a joint venture between the Royal Australian Navy and AMDA

Foundation Limited, organiser of Indo Pacific, to provide a \$15,000 scholarship for further training and personal development in the field of engineering.

The scholarship is in memory of Rear Admiral David Holthouse, AO, RAN, who held a distinguished career in the Royal Australian Navy, was passionate about naval engineering and was instrumental in the development of the Indo Pacific International Maritime Exposition.

INDO PACIFIC 2023

ANOTHER RECORD BREAKER ...



he numbers were always pointing towards another recordbreaking Indo Pacific, and now they confirm it: Indo Pacific 2023 was the largest yet.

The three-day event recorded a little over 27,000 attendances across the three days, up from 25,000 in 2022. This was in addition to:

- 832 participating exhibitor companies/ organisations from 21 nations, across a soldout exhibition floor 13% larger than our previous record event in 2022
- 171 defence, industry, government and academic delegations, from 46 nations. This is a 48% increase over 2022
- This included 25 International Chiefs of Navy or their counterparts and 21 representatives
- More than 90 conferences, symposia and presentations across the three days of the event

Justin Giddings, CEO of Indo Pacific 2023 organiser AMDA Foundation, said the numbers were impressive in their own right. But the main success of Indo Pacific 2023 was the quality of engagement amongst all who attended.

"The vibe around the halls was excellent and the exposure that Australian industry gained with both the Royal Australian Navy and international delegations was priceless," he said.

Mr Giddings congratulated the Royal Australian Navy on its inaugural Navy Life Expo, which saw school students touring a specialist area showcasing Navy's career opportunities, culture and leadership, training, lifestyle benefits and people, through interactive, youth-focused exhibits and demonstrations.

"I was in the Navy Life Expo several times, and it was very well attended, and obviously a great initiative," Mr. Giddings said.

"Another great highlight was the visit from Acting Prime Minister Richard Marles and his commitment to engaging with industry on the floor."

Mr Giddings also paid his respects to Australian Chief of Navy, Vice Admiral Mark Hammond.

"The Chief of Navy dedicated a great deal of time to talking with and listening to industry at Indo Pacific 2023. This direct engagement is critical to an understanding of the capabilities Navy seeks, and how industry may deliver them. We thank the Chief of Navy for his commitment in this area."

1913 the Royal Australian Navy's brand-new fleet sailed through the Heads and into Sydney Harbour. Since then the RAN has served on all the world's oceans in times of peace and war.

During the Second World War, the RAN reached its maximum strength. Approximately 37,000 men and women wore a RAN uniform. The war inflicted a heavy toll on ships and personnel. Thirty-eight cruisers, destroyers, sloops and smaller vessels were sunk and almost 2,200 sailors died on active service.

Since the end of the Second World War, the RAN's fortunes have fluctuated dramatically between lavish acquisitions and slashed defence budgets.

The RAN has sent ships and service personnel to war in Korea, Vietnam and the Persian Gulf. The service has participated in peacekeeping and humanitarian operations all over the globe, at sea, on remote islands and in tri-service deployments. It has played a vital role in protecting our borders and interrupting the international drug trade.

Today the RAN is a highly technical force of state-of-the-art equipment staffed by skilled and dedicated people serving the white ensign in the best traditions of Francis Drake and Horatio Nelson.

To recognise the generations of Australians who have gone to war on great waters the Anzac Memorial will open a year-long exhibition on the Royal Australian Navy on the anniversary of the Battle of Cape Matapan, 27 March 2023.

CANCER RESEARCH REVEALS LUNG CANCER NAVY VETS ...

University of Adelaide and Oxford University study has discovered asbestos exposure led to a higher incidence of asbestos-related lung cancers in British and Australian naval personnel than in other armed forces.

The data sets were collected from 30,085 United Kingdom and Australian personnel who served in the '50s and '60s, a time when asbestos-containing materials were present in British and Australian payal vessels.

Three of the four cohorts had previously been studied by the University of Adelaide and the UK Health Security Agency to identify the effects of radiation exposure from British nuclear testing; however, a raised incidence of mesothelioma, a cancer strongly linked to asbestos exposure, was seen in naval personnel in all cohorts.

The University of Adelaide's Dr Richie Gun and Oxford University's Dr Gerry Kendall were prompted by this finding to examine the dataset for the occurrence of lung cancers, which can also arise from asbestos exposure.



Meanwhile, the fourth cohort was Australian veterans of the Korean War, which had been studied by the Australian Department of Veterans' Affairs and the Australian Institute of Health and Welfare.

Dr Gun said, "We found the lung cancer rate was higher overall in naval personnel than in the other armed services, and, while smoking remains the dominant cause of lung cancer, it is unlikely the excess could be explained by a higher smoking rate in the navy."

The researchers have estimated that the proportion of lung cancers related to onboard asbestos exposure were of the order of 27 per cent in Australian seamen and 12 per cent in British seamen.

"Although actual measurements of airborne asbestos levels were not available, and estimates are difficult, we have concluded that the higher lung cancer rate in sailors was most probably caused by onboard asbestos exposure. This conclusion was strengthened by the occurrence of deaths in sailors from asbestosis, a condition which is non-cancerous but is nevertheless disabling and potentially fatal," Dr Gunn explained.

While there is a ban on imports and strict regulatory control of asbestos-containing materials in Australia, they still pose a risk to workers and some householders. There were 142 cases of asbestosis and 111 asbestosis deaths in 2021–22 reported in the NSW Dust Diseases Register.

Dr Gun explained that the effects of asbestos exposure are likely being underestimated unless lung cancer is considered alongside mesothelioma and asbestosis.

"Although it remains true that smoking causes most lung cancers, other agents such as asbestos can contribute to the incidence of cancer in an exposed population. Moreover, we know from other studies that the combination of smoking and asbestos exposure has an enhanced influence on lung cancer risk; this interactive effect would have contributed to the observed lung cancer excess," he said.

The discovery of a link between asbestos exposure and a higher incidence of lung cancer is a timely reminder of the need for protections against exposure to other harmful airborne dusts.






